 - Morley Farm June 3, 1831 Lyman Wight saw heavens opened after being set apart HP
 - John Johnson Farm see D&C 76 Joseph Smith and Sydney Rigdon Degrees of Glory
 - Whitney Store January 23, 1833 Ordinance of the Washing of Feet, divine manifestations occurred
 - Kirtland Temple see D&C 137 Vision of the Celestial Kingdom
 - Multiple visions of Jesus Christ
 - Manifestations at Temple 1836
 - Moses, Elias & Elijah appeared & restored keys see D&C 110
 - Angels appeared to many
 - Heavenly singing heard
 - Speaking in tongues
 - A bright light shown on roof
 - Visions of ancient prophets
